Full papers should be no more than 10 pages and short papers should be no more than 4 pages, conforming to formatting instructions available on the conference website. Each paper will be judged on its originality, significance, technical quality, relevance and presentation. APCCM 2019 proceedings will be published in the ACM International Conference Proceedings Series and included in the ACM Digital Library as part of a joint proceedings for ACSW.
